Yet the means of achieving full equality for the various groups working and learning within higher education are far from clear. Some argue that the advancement of equity is losing ground as it competes with the more prominent policies promoting efficiency and excellence. Who, then, is being privileged and who is not? The fourteen essays in this collection convey the tensions, contradictions and possibilities involved in working and learning within the university, and how equity and gender shape experiences. While gender is a central organising theme, contributors integrate various other aspects of identity into their discussions. The first section explores the ways in which radicalised minority women in positions of authority, Aboriginal women in social work and women with disabilities are represented as belonging. The second section looks at challenges facing Black scholars, women who have endured trauma, queer and gendered individuals and Aboriginal students -- those who do not easily fit within what is the conceptualised norm.
