According to the English decisions, that provision is already covered by the present Act; but the Rome Convention specifically covers it, and it seems expedient to make our Act conform in express terms. The fourth section, I do not think, should cause us any difficulty. It was an error in our original Copyright Act to make, in the case of joint authorship, the term to expire fifty years from the death of the author who dies first; whereas, in our treaty obligations, we assented to the term expiring fifty years from the death of the author who died last. Then, to conform with the Rome Convention, section five is suggested. It gives the author the right to restrain acts which are prejudicial to his honour or reputation, even although he may have assigned the Copyright in his work.
